Getting Started...The Admissions Process

Life Christian Academy is a selective admissions school looking for students whose lives, achievements, and goals best exemplify the mission of our school. Life Christian Academy works in cooperation with families who want their students to participate in a Christian study-abroad program to the United States.

- Step 1:** Complete an International Student Application for Admission, along with all forms outlined on the International Student New Admission Process–Tuition & Fees Schedule including:
- One letter of reference in English from a pastor, teacher or adult non-relative who has known the applicant for at least two years.
 - Submit transcripts of all academic courses including grade 9 and above (translated in English).
 - Provide proof of financial responsibility (bank document) in American dollars to cover tuition and expenses.
- Step 2:** Submit the Application for Admission. The non-refundable enrollment deposit of \$325 must be included, along with all the forms outlined above.
- Step 3:** Submit iTep or TOEFL score.
- Step 4:** A Skype interview will be scheduled once steps one and two are completed. Requirements include:
- Conversing in English.
 - A 100 word essay on a topic we will provide during interview.
 - Reading an English text which we will provide.
- Step 5:** Once accepted - \$3,000 non-refundable deposit required to secure I-20.

The SEVIS I-20 form is issued by Life Christian Academy after the application process has been completed and the student has been accepted for admission. It is the agency/family responsibility to follow up with the American Embassy to insure the F-1 student visa is issued prior to the student’s first day of school.
