



**INTERNATIONAL TUITION FOR 2017-2018 – NEW STUDENT ADMISSION PROCESS**

**INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ENROLLMENT DEPOSIT: \$325 (NON-REFUNDABLE)**

Due at time of submitting International Student Application for Admission.

**APPLICATION PROCEDURE:**

- Complete International Student Application for Admission, return to Life Christian Academy with the following items:
  - Include - \$325 Enrollment Deposit
  - Include - Copy of Passport
  - Include - Medical History/Emergency Consent Form
  - Include - Certificate of Immunization Status Form or other proof of immunization record
  - Include - Authorization for Temporary Guardianship of Minor Form
  - Include - Medical Consent & Field Trip Permission Form
  - Include - One letter of reference in English from a pastor, a teacher, or adult non-relative who has known applicant for several years.
  - Include - Transcripts for all high school academic courses, including 9<sup>th</sup> grade translated in English. For applicants entering grades 3-8, include courses for the past two years translated in English.
  - Include - 200 word essay in applicant’s own words (see application form).
  - Include - Bank document showing financial responsibility in American dollars to cover all applicant’s expenses.
  - If student is transferring from another school in the United States, include a copy of the current I-20, Passport, VISA, and I-94.
- Upon receipt of application paperwork a Skype interview will be scheduled.
- Application will be processed and submitted to Admissions Committee (takes approximately two weeks).
- Notification of acceptance or denial sent to the family. If accepted, the I-20 will be issued and sent to the family with our letter of acceptance via Express Mail.
  - Submit iTep or TOEFL Score

**TOTAL COST PER STUDENT (NON-REFUNDABLE):**

Tuition: Grades 3-5 -- \$25,200 / Grades 6-8 -- \$31,600 / Grades 9-12 -- \$35,500

- \$3,000 non-refundable deposit required to secure I-20, which will be subtracted from total tuition amount.
- International tuition and fees **must be** paid in full prior to student starting school. For students who begin school at the start of second semester, tuition will be half the annual fee.
